How do I make a mentorship submission?

Who should apply

- Authors whose backgrounds and communities are not well represented in the genre
- Debut, unpublished or self-published authors
- Not repped by a literary agent
- Living in Canada, U.S. and its territories

What to submit

- Original, unpublished stories
- First 5,000 words of your story, full plot summary
 - don't forget the ending!
- Cover letter with a short story pitch (teaser), your bio, any previous writing credits or programs
- Personal statement in your cover letter why you applied, what you expect, what greater diversity in the romance genre means to you personally

How to submit

- Read the details on WriteForHarlequin.com
- Prepare your submission
- When ready, go to Harlequin.Submittable.com
- Choose the "2025 Romance Includes You Mentorship" inbox
- Accepting submissions May 1 31
- Hit "submit" button and upload your Word documents
 - Cover letter
 - First 5,000 words and synopsis in one Word doc
- One submission only please
